What is Parent and Child Fostering?

Usually, but not always, a young parent and their baby will come and live with you for a 12-week assessment period where you will observe, guide, and encourage the parent to meet their child's day-to-day needs, whilst ensuring the child is safeguarded at all times. This gives the parent the best opportunity to then move on to live independently with their child after a period of time.

There are many reasons why a Parent and Child placement is needed, including poor mental health, a learning disability, alcohol or drug use, and domestic violence.

Requirements

- A spare bedroom
- Experience of caring for 0-5 year olds and knowledge of current infant care
- Ability to produce clear and precise records including observations
- Ability to 'stand back' and encourage parents to meet the child's day-to-day needs, whilst ensuring the child is safeguarded

What you will receive

- £823* a week plus a child maintenance allowance
- 2 weeks paid holiday at the end of every 12-week assessment period
- Ongoing specialist training and support
