What is Remand Fostering?

Remand Fostering is a specialist scheme which supports children and young people who are, or have been, involved in criminal activity by placing them with specialist Foster Carers.

Remand Foster Carers will have a dedicated support network and provide the children and young people with a safe and therapeutic environment until the court makes a decision. This could be reuniting with their birth family, a fostering family, or a custodial sentence where the young person would be placed in a Young Offender.

Requirements

- A spare bedroom
- Be available to foster full-time
- Experience of working with children and young people i.e. residential, youth work
- A full driving licence and access to a car
- Resilience, determination, and a commitment to achieving good outcomes
- Committed to training and developing key skills and expertise

What you will receive

- £485* per week plus a child maintenance allowance, and 8 weeks paid leave
- Specialist training including PREVENT, PACE, and County Lines
- Support from relevant stakeholders such as the Youth Offending Team, TESS, and Forward-Thinking Birmingham
- Part of an Emergency Foster Carer Support Pod
- Robust transition when a child has been matched
