What is Remand Fostering?

Remand fostering is a specialist scheme supporting children and young people who are, or have been, involved in criminal activity by placing them with specialist foster carers. It provides a valuable alternative to custody, offering young people the stability, structure and guidance they need at a critical point in their lives. A real chance to move forward positively.

Requirements

- A spare bedroom
- Be available to foster full-time and to provide flexible fostering support/emergency foster care when you don't have a child placed with you
- Experience supporting children or young people (e.g., youth work, residential care, education, police, probation, or previous fostering)
- Ability to travel to locations and transport children across the city
- Resilience, determination, and commitment to helping young people thrive
- Willingness to take part in specialist training

What you will receive

- £893 per week plus child maintenance allowance and 6 weeks paid leave
- Specialist training including PREVENT, PACE, and County Lines awareness
- Support from Youth Offending Teams, TESS, and Forward-Thinking Birmingham
- Therapeutic support and dedicated supervising social worker
- Clear and supported transition planning for every child
- 24/7 support, 365 days per year
